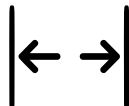


TEACHING SPEAKING

Here are some classic recipes for activating your students' powers of communication and getting them speaking and using their language functionally in class. Online or F2F.

INFO GAPS



Communicate to fill in incomplete information.

ROLE PLAY



Students pretend to be a character in a certain situation.

MINGLING



Move around the class and survey others, get info.

DIALOGUES



Speak with each other using a script or ad-lib.

STORYTELLING



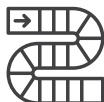
Tell and retell stories or jokes to each other in class.

PICTURE PROMPTS



Use pictures to elicit speech and talk about things.

GAMES



Play games where students have to speak to advance.

DISCUSSION & DEBATE



Students answer questions and provide opinions on a topic.

PUBLIC SPEAKING



Students give a simple, structured speech.

CONVERSATION



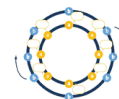
Students talk about routines, regular life, news, gossip.

INTERVIEWS



Interview each other or a guest like a real talk show.

INSIDE - OUTSIDE



Two circles, face a partner and relay information.

FREE SPEAKING



Student choice. Plan an event. Hot topic. Issues.

Use online tools for skills development, pronunciation.
